

El Molino Student Directions:

- Complete your Student Dance Contract.
- Give this form to your guest, after completing box 1, so that he/she can complete it and get it back to you **at least 3 days prior** to the date of the dance.
- Turn this Guest Pass into the El Molino mail office **at least 3 days prior** to the date of the dance.

Guest Directions:

- Read the Student Dance Contract Guest Pass form completely and then sign in Box 2.
- Have your parent/guardian read and sign this form in Box 2. Include an emergency phone number
- Obtain your school administrator's signed permission (Box 3) and have them attach a business card to the form. If you are not in High School please complete either Box 4 or Box 5, which ever box applies.
- Return this form to your El Molino host **Bring a photo ID to the dance or you will not be admitted.**

Dance Guidelines and Expected Student Behavior

1. The dance begins at 8:00 p.m. and ends at 11:00 p.m. All students attending the dance should make arrangements for transportation home by 11:00 p.m.
2. Students will demonstrate good character, be respectful and courteous towards all students and chaperones.
3. Individuals who are not dressed appropriately will be turned away and no refunds will be given. Shoes must be worn. Appropriate dress must be maintained throughout the dance.
4. No entries will be allowed after 10:00 p.m. All students must arrive at the dance by 10:00 p.m. to attend. Once you arrive at the dance you must remain at the dance. When you leave you may not return.
5. Personal belongings and outerwear may be searched.
6. A test may be administered to ticket-holders upon entry to discourage alcohol/drug use.
7. The manner of dancing will be appropriate for a school function. Sexually explicit dancing such as freaking, grinding, or any other type of dancing which could be construed as vulgar or provocative is prohibited. This includes: dancing styles that involve intimate touching of the breasts, buttocks, or genitals, or that simulate sexual activity. All dancers must remain upright—no sexual squatting or sexual bending is allowed, i.e., no hands on knees and no hands on the dance floor with your buttocks facing or touching your dance partner. Students violating the above guideline will include removal from the Dance, an immediate phone call to the student's parent with the requirement that the student's parent will pick up their student immediately. Students violating guideline **will NOT** be allowed to attend future El Molino dances.

***No refunds will be given if a student is directed to leave before the end of the dance.**
